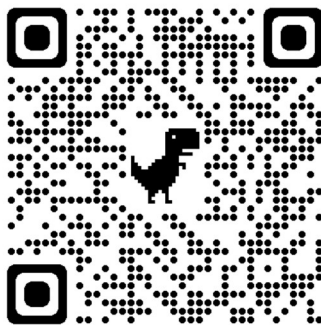

If you are not displaying this decal on your watercraft, it is time to have a Vessel Safety Check performed.

Free Vessel Safety Check by United States Power Squadrons open to everyone!



Boat safety inspectors do not issue citations but provide a completed written inspection report that allows owners and operators to make recommended improvements to the safety equipment used on their boat. Inspectors look for properly working equipment such as fire extinguishers, life jackets, horns, and navigational lights. Safety checks can be performed on all types of watercraft.



Please sign up in advance to ensure we have the necessary number of Vessel Safety Examiners to provide this service. Use the QR code to the left to sign up online or use the sign-up sheet in the marina office.

Please review the [Boating Safety Check List](#) and locate all required items in your boat before your vessel is checked. Have all persons except the skipper leave the boat during the inspection. No inspections will be performed at the launch ramp or staging area.
